

WHAT WILL I SEE ON THE TOUR?

The Museum of Transport collection contains some 90 historical vehicles and is the most varied in the Country as well as being one of the largest collections in the Country.

The Museum is owned by the Greater Manchester Passenger Transport Executive and is operated on their behalf by the members of the Greater Manchester Transport Society which is a voluntary body.

The collection represents one hundred year of local road history with the emphasis on the once colourful and familiar buses which operated in the town around the Greater Manchester Area. In the past it was left to the twelve municipal transport undertakings and two private companies to provide transport, and each had its own characteristic colour scheme and vehicles.

The Museum now revives memories for people who were used to traveling to work and school on such vehicles and it also shows children of today how things have changed as well as the change in vehicles, also the changes in fare collection, uniforms etc.

The vehicles range from an 1890 horse bus up to the latest one man operated buses including experimental vehicles such as electric buses. There is also the prototype Metrolink tramcar. As well as displaying vehicles, there are also displays of smaller items such as photographs, ticket machines, uniforms and street furniture associated with public transport, as well as a whole range of other items. There is also a set of reconstructed offices which show what went on behind the scenes, the things that the average passengers never saw.
