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Membership Rewards - 'Find A Friend' scheme

If an **existing** member recruits a new **full** member (i.e. someone who has not been a full member of the Society for at least the last two years), then the recruiter will receive a voucher to spend in the Museum shop worth £5.

More than one voucher may be earned by recruiting more than one new member. The voucher may be redeemed at any time up to its expiry date but if only part of the value of a voucher is redeemed, no change will be payable on the unredeemed value. There is no cash alternative.

Gift Aid

If you pay Income Tax and/or Capital gains Tax you can increase the value of your subscription and donations to the Society by signing the Gift Aid declaration overleaf. This will be reclaimed from the Inland Revenue by the **Greater Manchester Transport Society** as a Registered Charity.

1. Please notify the Society of any change of name or address
2. You may cancel the declaration at any time
3. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the amount of tax that the Society reclaims on your subscription and donation in the tax year (currently 28p for every £1 given).
4. If, in the future, your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax which the Society reclaims, you should cancel your declaration.
5. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief on your Self Assessment form.
6. If you are unsure whether your subscription and donations qualify for Gift Aid relief, ask the Society or pick up leaflet 'IR113 Gift Aid' from your local tax office.

Data Protection – Collection Notice

1. The Greater Manchester Transport Society may use your information to provide and enhance our services to you. If you need to provide us with sensitive personal data, e.g. health information, you consent to our processing this data where this is necessary for these purposes.
