

THE TRANS-LANCS RALLY 2010

The Trans Lancs Rally is the annual Transport Festival organised by the Greater Manchester Transport Society based at the Museum of Transport, Boyle Street, Cheetham, Manchester M8 8UW.

The event often referred to as the Heaton Park Rally, keeps its original title The Trans Lancs which dates back to the days when the road run crossed Lancashire. Now the name is purely historical and the actual road run is from the Museum of Transport in Cheetham Hill to the fine Heaton Park in Prestwich, a run of approximately 15 miles.

The rally caters for all types of vehicles including preserved and modern buses, military and commercial vehicles, cars and motorcycles, each entrant will also receive a programme and commemorative plaque. Vehicles will be displayed in class order;
Auto jumble sites are available for a fee of £20.00. Strictly no food or drinks.

The Museum will be open from 07.30 hrs on the Sunday morning and hot and cold snacks will be available within the Tea Rooms.
The first vehicle will depart on the road run at 11.00 hrs.

For any entrant wishing to arrive on Saturday 4th September we have limited spaces for secure overnight accommodation within the Museum for your vehicle and there is a selection of good hotels within easy reach of the Museum. **Vehicle spaces will be allocated on a first come, first served basis therefore we must have early notification. Entrants must arrive with their vehicle no later than 4pm on Saturday evening. For insurance reasons, we cannot permit guests to stay within the Museum overnight.**

Heaton Park is one of the largest parks in Europe and is a most attractive venue consisting of acres of parkland which include many facilities both for preservation enthusiasts, their families and friends. The park also has a large boating lake, children's playground, animal farm and Heaton Hall, which houses a collection of pottery and paintings.
These facilities are all to be found within the pleasant surroundings of the park, providing a superb location for our rally.

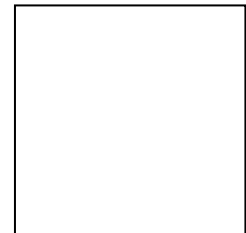
